

THE NAME OF THE HOLDING

The reference to a holding (Château, Domaine, Clos, etc.) is reserved for wines benefiting from an AOC/AOP or IGP. The wine must be produced exclusively from grapes harvested in the vineyards operated by this holding and the winemaking must be carried out within it.

THE WINE-MAKING MARK

The wine mark is a geographical mark referring to a geographical place or more precisely to a holding.

NAME AND ADDRESS OF BOTTLER

The information about the bottler must appear on the label and is supplemented by the words "bottler" or "bottled by...".

THE ACTUAL ALCOHOLIC STRENGTH BY VOLUME (TAVA)

The label must indicate the alcoholic strength of the beverage, and the differential cannot be more or less than 0,5% of the strength determined by analysis.

THE FIGURATIVE MARK

The logo may be protected by the registration of a figurative mark.

THE VINTAGE

Indication of the vintage is possible if at least 85% of the grapes used to produce the wine were harvested in the year indicated.

DESIGNATION OF ORIGIN CONTROLLED OR PROTECTED (AOC/AOP)

The wines benefiting from such a designation may make it appear supplemented by the geographical name.

THE INDICATION OF ORIGIN

This information must appear on the label of all wines. It guarantees the consumer the origin of the grapes and the country where the wine was made.

NOMINAL VOLUME

It is compulsory to indicate the volume of the bottle of wine.
